

Borer are a very common insect found in many older New Zealand homes. They feed on wood and are typically identified when they create small holes as they exit timber work. Borer larvae live in timber for 2-3 years before emerging in the warmer months in 'beetle' like form to breed and sometimes move house! Control of this pest is essential to avoid costly long term damage and preserve the structural integrity of your home.

**Borer Basher**™ is a preventive maintenance measure for controlling borer in your home. The active ingredient is a natural borate compound originating from mineral deposits. It is sprayed onto exposed timer in liquid form, soaking in and creating a semi - permanent defence from borer. The best time to apply the product is when most of the timber work is exposed (such as before insulation is laid).
